



Request for Official Endorsement

The mission of Presbyterian Church Camp and Conference Association is to equip leaders for ministries of discipleship, community building, and the care of Creation. As this network of camp and conference professionals works to attain these goals, it requests a partnership with the camps and conference centers of The Presbyterian Church in Canada. We believe that this relationship will lead to stronger and more effective camps and conference centers on both sides of the international border. It will give our sites a forum to share ideas, resources, and best practices. This partnership will also provide fellowship and mutual support to volunteers and professionals in Presbyterian camp and conference ministry.

As a part of this relationship, PCCCA agrees to the following conditions:

- The organization will now consider itself a body that serves the Presbyterian camps and conference centers of both the United States and Canada.
- All of its resources, services, and advocacy will serve the sites related to the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) and The Presbyterian Church in Canada.
- The association will extend three years of free membership to each of the Canadian sites (2009-2011). During this three year period, each of these sites will also receive a one-time program fee scholarship to a PCCCA Annual Conference or a PCCCA Program Connection of their choice.
- As the Canadian camps and conference centers become more involved with the association, some of the PCCCA events will take place in Canada or at least closer to the United States-Canadian border.

As a part of this relationship, we make the following requests of The Presbyterian Church in Canada:

- That PCCCA would be endorsed as the recognized international association for the camps and conference centers of the denomination.
- That the PCCCA website would display the official directory of the PCC camps and conference centers and that a hyperlink to this website would become part of the PCC website.
- That PCCCA would have permission to use the logo of the denomination on its website, letterhead, brochures, and promotional materials.
- That a letter would be sent to the camps and conference centers of the denomination to announce the new relationship and to encourage their participation in the association.

We look forward to the fruits of this new partnership.
