LODGING AND TRANSPORTATION

Hopewell Camp and Conference Center, which is owned by the Presbytery of St. Andrew, is located in the beautiful Holly Springs National Forest about 5 minutes outside of Oxford, Mississippi. While at Hopewell, you will stay in one of their lodges. Linens will be provided. All meals will be served buffet style. If you have any dietary restrictions, please note this on your registration form so we can accommodate your requests.

Hopewell is about 75 minutes from the Memphis International Airport. We will provide a shuttle from the airport at 7:30pm, so plan to arrive by 7:00pm on Friday. The program will not officially begin until Saturday morning at breakfast, but we ask participants who are driving to arrive at Hopewell some time between 6:00 and 9:00pm on Friday night. The weekend will conclude with a worship service held after breakfast on Sunday, so the shuttle will leave at 10:00am. Please schedule your departure flight after 1:30pm.

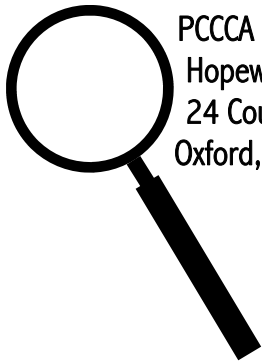
