AIRPORT SHUTTLES

HOUSING

Participants will be housed in Pine Lodge, a climate-controlled building with its own porch and meeting area. All rooms are private occupancy with shared restrooms.

FLIGHT ARRANGEMENTS

Flights should be booked to Tampa International Airport (TPA), located an hour from Cedarkirk.

WHAT TO BRING

Comfortable clothes for cool to warm weather (avg. temps in February range from 55F/12c to 77F/25c); toiletries; walking shoes; note-taking materials.
